

## **Curtis Pond Pool Rules**

Curtis Pond is a Swim At Your Own Risk pool. There are no lifeguards.

The Curtis Pond Pool is for the pleasure & enjoyment of Curtis Pond Members in good standing & their guests only. These rules are to ensure the safety of all pool users.

Each person is required to follow the rules of the pool, cooperate with and follow all directions of the Pool Monitors ( Pool Security Committee members, Pool Committee members and board members) and respect the rights of others. Failure to do so may result in the Member & their guests being asked to leave the pool for not less than 24 hours. The Pool Monitor will report serious incidents to the board & a hearing may be scheduled to consider the suspension of Member rights to the pool if a Member or their guests fail to follow the rules.

### **Entry**

By entering the pool gate you accept that you are swimming at your own risk and are responsible for informing your guests that there are no lifeguards on duty. You take responsibility for the safety of your guests and minor children and for their behavior.

A valid Pool Pass and an active FOB are required at all times for admittance.

Each person is required to have their Pool Pass available for inspection by the Pool Monitors at all times while in the pool area. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

Each household is allowed to have a maximum of 4 guests at any one time.

Absolutely NO children under the age of 16 will be allowed to enter the pool unless accompanied by an adult (18 years of age or older). An adult MUST supervise children under age 16 at ALL times. Please DO NOT leave the pool area if you are an adult responsible for supervising children younger than 16. If children are found in the pool area unsupervised they will be removed from the pool until you return. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

16 year old Member children ARE allowed in the pool without an adult. They must have a valid Pool Pass and are NOT allowed to bring guests into the pool.

Please DO NOT drop off children younger than 16 or anyone who does not have a valid Pool Pass. They WILL NOT be allowed entry into the pool. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

Parties of more than four guests:

Members who plan to have more than four guests per household at the pool should speak to Ben Rhodes with Kuester Management Company by calling 888-600-5044 to make arrangements at least 2 weeks in advance. A failure to do so will result in you and your guests not being allowed to use the pool. We will have a list of those who have called ahead with the gate monitor. Members are responsible for their guests.

### **Pool Health and Safety**

Please shower before entering the pool.

Hair longer than shoulder length should be confined by hair net or other hair restraints.

Infants and untrained children should wear a swim diaper or plastic pants over a diaper at all times.

Persons with skin abrasions, colds, infections, inflamed eyes or wearing bandages should not use the pool to prevent the spread of sickness & disease.

In the event that thunder is heard or lightning is seen by swimmers or Pool Monitors the pool and deck area will be cleared

until the severe weather risk has ended and it is safe to return to the water.

If the pool becomes polluted with feces, vomit, or other potentially infectious materials the pool will immediately be closed and treated chemically according to state health regulations and will not reopen until the process has been completed and the pool is considered clean and safe for swimming.

Flotation devices may only be used by young children if the parent is within arms reach.

The use of larger flotation devices may be used only if they do not interfere with the enjoyment of the pool by all swimmers.

No pets are allowed in the pool area except for certified service animals.

No bicycles, skateboards, scooters or roller blades are to be used inside the pool area.

### **Pool Conduct**

Members are responsible for their children and their guests.

Do not hold the gate open for anyone. Non-Members are not allowed entry unless they are guests of Members. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

Do not climb over the fence. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

There will be no running, pushing, wrestling, or horseplay in the pool.

There will be no profanity or abusive language at any time in the pool area.

No food or beverage will be allowed in the pool.

No gum or glass containers are allowed inside the pool area.

Smoking will be restricted to the designated smoking area. Failure to remain within that area will result in suspension of pool privileges.

No underage smoking.

Colorfast swimwear only will be allowed in the pool.

No jeans, cutoffs or inappropriate attire will be allowed in the swimming pool.

Pool life saving equipment is only to be used in the event of an emergency.

Pool telephone is for emergency use only. It is not to be used for any calls other than 911. Failure to follow this rule will result in the suspension of your pool privileges.

Pool use is limited to scheduled times only.

Pool privileges and access to the common areas and other amenities are the right of renters unless the Member who holds title to the property in question suspends them for any reason, or that Member has had their Members Rights suspended by the BOD. Renters are responsible for following all of the rules. As in the case of a Member, if a renter is asked to leave the pool for failure to follow the rules or the direction of a lifeguard a hearing with the Board of Directors may be scheduled to consider the suspension of Member rights. Any such suspension will apply to renters.
